First Day Call Procedures

We have been reviewing our 'First Day Call' procedures in school. This happens when parents/carers do not contact school regarding their child's absence. All pupil absences should be reported to the school office by telephone or answerphone message when the office is closed. The following procedures will be carried out by office staff when we do not hear from parents/carers in order to comply with our Safeguarding policy:

After registers are taken and absences calls noted, a list of children absent without any explanation will be made A double check will be made in school before calls are started Call everyone on the contact list until an answer is obtained. Leave messages if there is a voicemail option If no answer, call every contact a second time If no reply received from anyone on the contact list, ask Senior Leadership Team (SLT) if the child has additional agency support Yes – Hannah No - Hannah or (FSW) or SLT to SLT to carry out a contact social prompt home worker visit If the door is not answered and no contact has been made, refer immediately to Children's

Services/Police – request a welfare call.
