



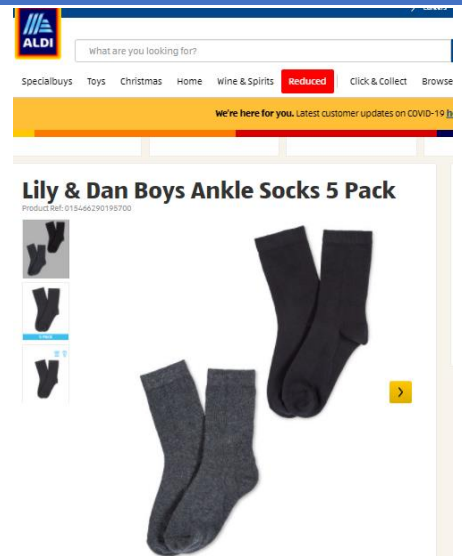
Lingey House Primary and Nursery School

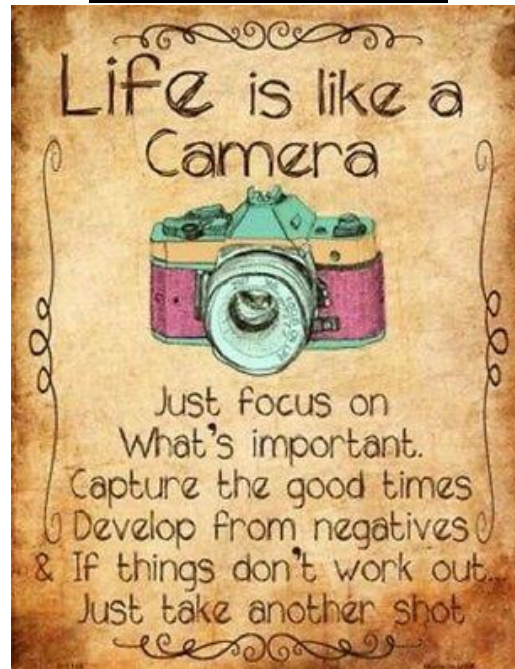
We would like you to support your child at home in the following ways:

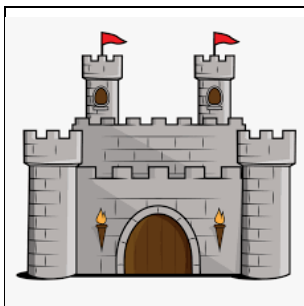
