I hope you all have a lovely half term!

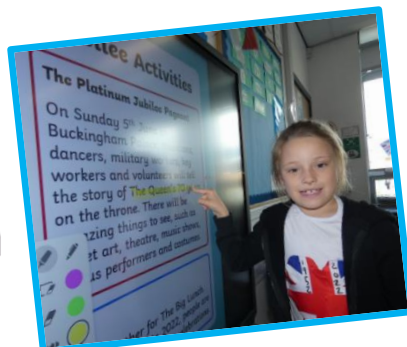
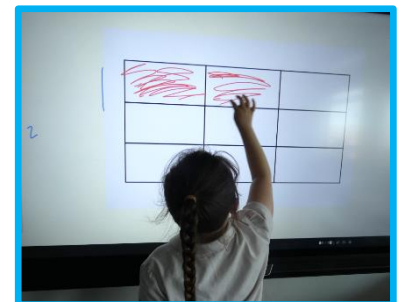

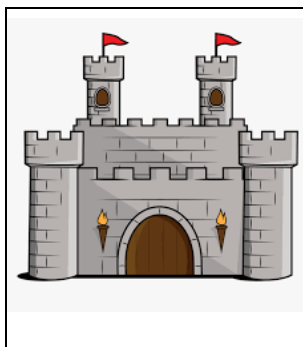
