If there Asthma medication/dosage has changed at their last review, we may require another Asthma Card to be completed.

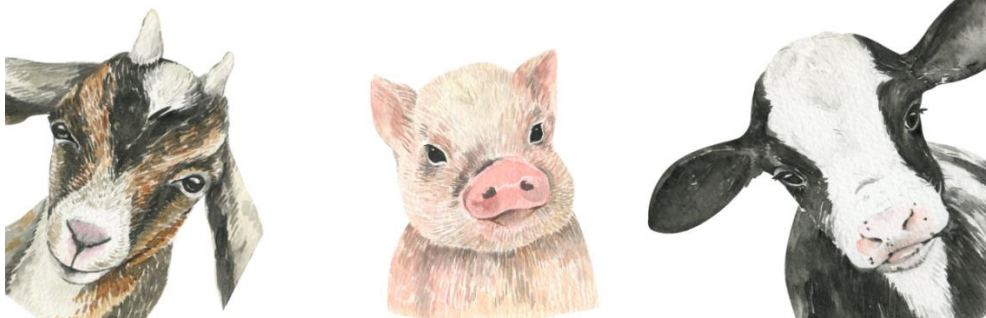
