Please note, all conversations will be treated confidentially, this support is not means tested.

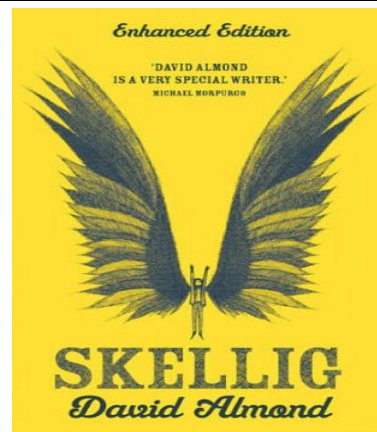


Author Visit – David Almond
