Lingeybury



To celebrate the end of year 6, we are inviting all our year 6 pupils to Lingeybury! This is a fun event where children can party, dress up and enjoy themselves!

Change to 30 Hours Entitlement for Nursery Students

Currently our nursery students attend for 32.5 hours per week, as this is above the 30 hour entitlement we are amending the allocation of hours from September 2025.

30 hour students will attend Lingey House from 8.45am Until 3.15pm Monday to Thursday then 8.45am until 12.45pm on Friday. We will have the option to extend the Friday session for an additional 2 hours 30 minutes at a cost of £15.00 which will need to booked in with the school office for a half tem in advance- payments will be made via Arbor.




Local Author






