Reorganising A and B Classes

They have considered friendships, needs of children, SEND, behaviours, personalities, mental health, confidence and a whole host of other things. We have looked at the advantages and disadvantages of doing this but really feel that this will have many benefits and is really needed in all year groups.

Class Organisation for September

Today, children will be finding out who the class teachers in each year group will be in September and I have included this information for you below. We have made a few changes and all staff are excited to be working with new year-group partners or teaching a different year group in school. All teachers in school are qualified to teach from Nursery up to Year 6, so rest assured that all teachers are able to adapt their practice to meet the needs and age of children in their class.



On Tuesday, we will be having a 'move up day' in school. Children will find out if they are in class A or B and will spend some time in their new class with their new teacher. We feel this will minimise children's and parents' apprehension and overthinking leading up to Move up Day. Children will begin and end their day in their current class so children will enter school in their usual way.

Staff have worked really hard to reorganise classes and are confident that children will thrive in their new class. We all know some children find change harder than others but hopefully, Tuesday will be a great success and children will come home happy feeling that they are still with some familiar friends but are also able to get to know other children in their year group. 




Nursery
